Irish athletic news: This past weekend the Fighting Irish boys and girls represented the Irish community very well. On the girls side, the following girls all placed in the state meet: Erica Hutson placed in 2nd place in the 400 meter dash, 6th in the 200 meter dash, anchored the 5th place 4 by 200 team and 8th place 4 x 400 team; the remaining members of the 4 x 200 team was Nashay Willis, Jen Murray and Chelsea Laury; the girls 4 x 400 team consisting of Sam Kirk, Tessa Weigand, Rachel Hutson, Erica Hutson and Chelsea Laury finished in 8th place; the girls 4 x 800 relay team won the state title. The team consisted of Emily Tomei, Tessa Weigand, Sam Kirk and Maria Arnone. On the boys side, the following events and individuals placed in the state meet: the boy's 4 x 800 relay team finished in 4th place with the team of Patrick O'Brien, Jacob Swords, Ian Walsh and Sean Poholski; the boy's 4 x 200 relay team finished in 7th place with the team of Sae'Von Fitzgerald, Matt Matuska, Carrington Glenn and Doran Grant; Jacob Swords finished in 4th place in the 800 meter run; Doran Grant won a state title in the 110 hurdles with a fantastic lean at the finish to capture the title. The girls team finished 4th in the state and the boys finished in 8th place as a team. Congratulations to all of the boys and girls of the Irish track and field team.
