CLASS OF 2011: WINNERS TO THE LAST MINUTE

This past school year was a "banner" year for STVM and for the graduating class of 2011. Indeed, their last day was fulfilled by the boys track team winning the first track state championship in the history of the school. This was almost lost in the long list of their accomplishments that also included the school's 6th state championship in boys basketball and 2nd team state championship in girls cross country. One wrestler also won a state championship. While those events were well covered in the sports sections of the media, their other major accomplishments were not so highly publicized.

Our symphonic band received a "Superior" rating in their district contest and then went "straight to state" for the first time in the history of the school and won 1st place there. Our Irish artists had more individual awards than ever at the state level as well, again setting a school record.

The science team brought home the state trophy yet again, and the rocket teams made it back to national competition. The new Mock Trial team and Model UN team both had successful inaugural years, as well.

These graduates had 98% heading off to college, and 97% were accepted at their first choice college. They garnered just under \$15 million in scholarships and grants, and that total is highly significant for a high school of our size.

BOOKS FOR BAHAMAS KICKS OFF SEPT. 26

The STVM Chapter of the National Honor Society will be sponsoring its annual "Books for the Bahamas" Project throughout the school. The goal of this project is to collect new or gently used children's books to send to the Bahamas Library Project. The elementary schools on many of the impoverished islands have few, if any, books in their school libraries, and with the help of our school, we would like to continue to assist the Project Group as they stock school libraries and enable the students in these schools to enjoy the pleasure of reading. Over the past several years, we have been able to donate nearly 15,000 books. The project "kicks off" on September 26 and concludes on October 14.

Members of National Honor Society will visit homerooms periodically to explain the project and encourage students to go through their grade school books at home and donate ones that they no longer have use for and are still in relatively good condition. Picture books, story books, fiction and non-fiction for children from infancy to about 6th grade would be appreciated. If they don't have any books, but would like to give a cash donation, NHS members will use the money to purchase used books or contribute it to the Bahamas Library Project Group. NHS appreciates any support the community can provide for this project.
