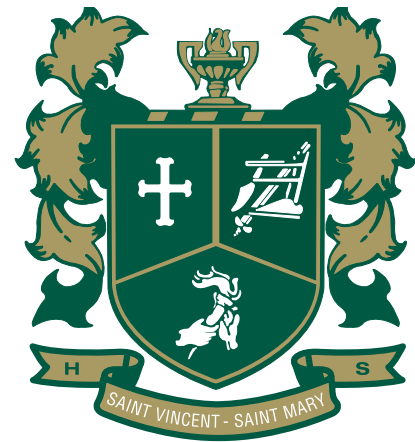
Dear STVM Community:

Once again, for the 2011-2012 school year, St. Vincent-St. Mary High School will offer sports-specific strength and conditioning training for all athletes. The training will be provided by 4th year Head Wrestling Coach Anthony Gary, who is a personal trainer certified by the National Strength and Conditioning Association (NSCA) and the American Council on Exercise (ACE).

There is no charge to STVM athletes for these services. Coach Gary will work with the students on a program to enhance their performance and prevent injury during the regular season, as well as pre- and post-season. Although athletes are not required to participate, they'll have an opportunity to meet as a team with Coach Gary once or twice a week to learn body weight and stretching exercises, including variations on martial arts and yoga techniques.

Coach Dan Lancianese's Notebook



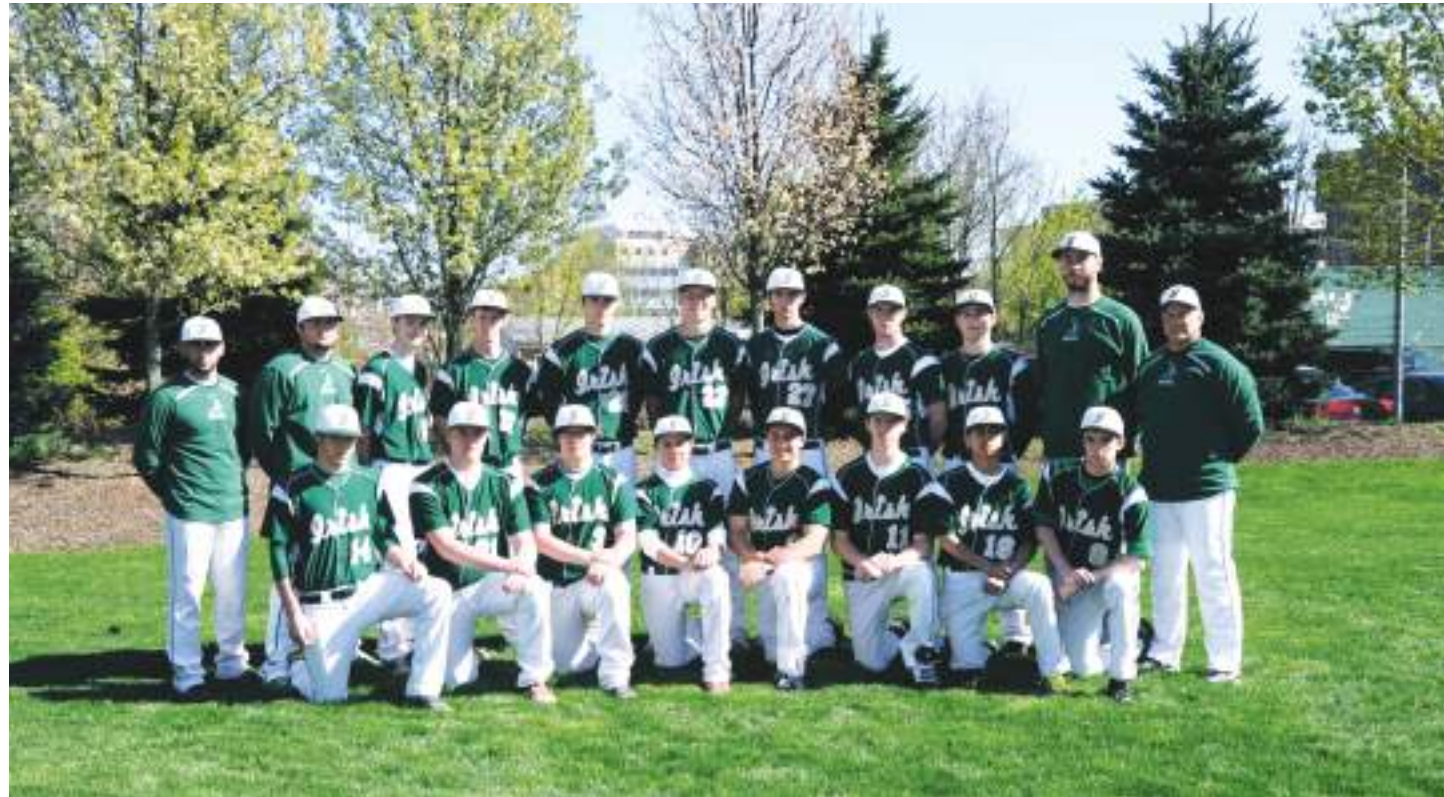

"The Fighting Irish Track team was impressive in the Spring 2011 season.

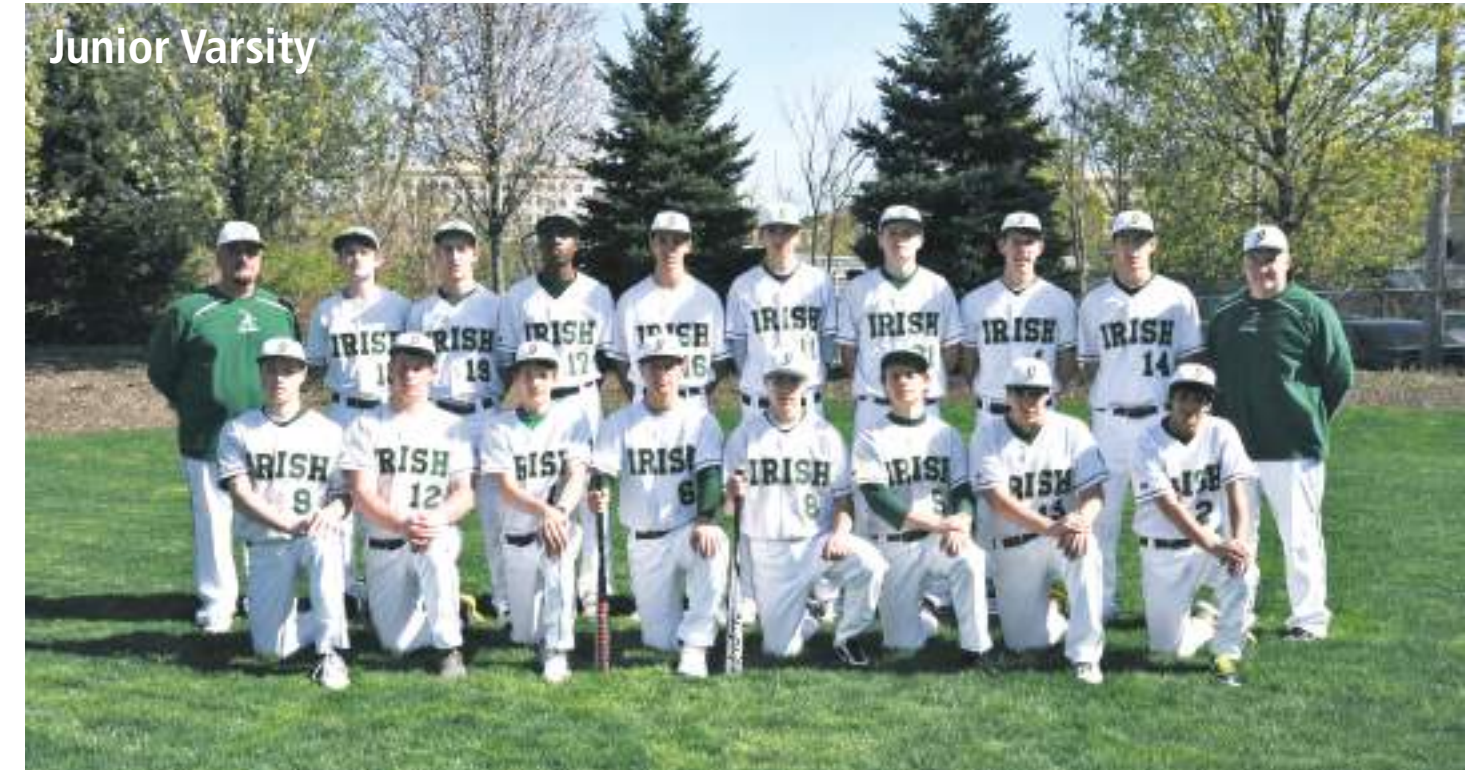

Coach Anthony Boarman's Notebook



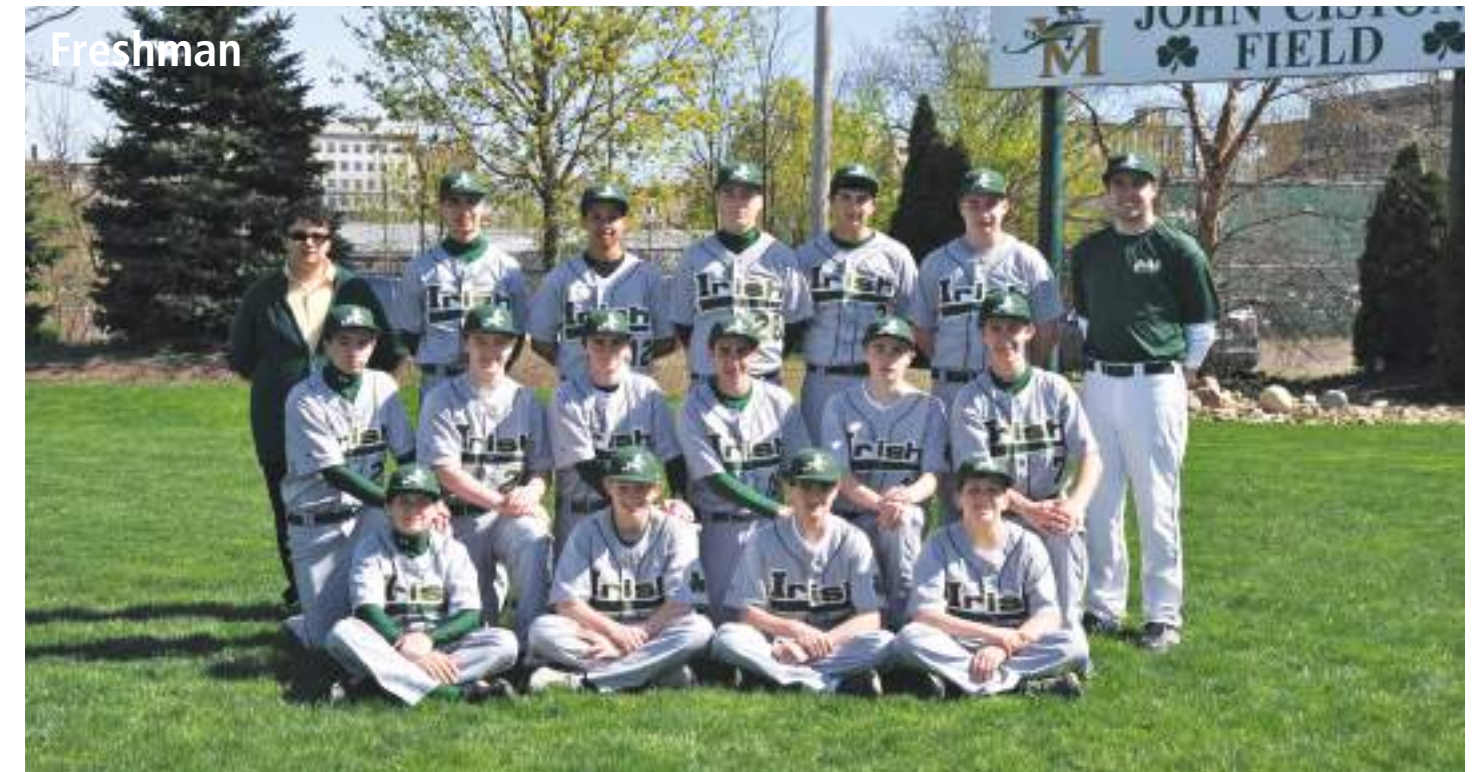
