2021-2022 HOME ATHLETIC EVENTS

FACILITY INFORMATION:

All on campus STVM events abide by the following rules:

1. STVM and all of its facilities are smoke free
2. STVM highly recommends that masks be worn by all patrons
 - a. Masks are mandatory for all players and coaches riding a bus
 - b. STVM is HIGHLY recommending that ALL spectators wear a mask at inside venues.
 - c. STVM is HIGHLY recommending that ALL spectators wear a mask at outdoor venues.
 - d. We ask and have been recommended by the OHSAA to ask our patrons, regardless of vaccination status, please continue to socially distance yourself.
3. Concessions are available at all sites. Green Street Stadium concessions accept cash and card
4. All events are ticketed and electronic only
5. After games, we ask all spectators to exit the facility in a rapid manner. If you are waiting for a player, we ask you to do so in the parking lot. We use this time to clean and/or flip the facility for the next game or school day.

Green Street Stadium:

TICKET INFORMATION:

Ticket Prices:

Football: All tickets are \$8.00

Soccer, Volleyball, Basketball, Lacrosse: Adults \$8.00 Students \$6.00

Effective 2021: There will be no limit on ticket purchases. All tickets are first come, first serve and sold online

1. All tickets are purchased online, via www.stvm.com/tickets
 - a. STVM WILL NOT BE TAKING CASH SALES; online sales only
 - b. Currently, there is no limit per transaction on home many tickets you have to buy
 - i. Our only cap is the total capacity of each facility
 - c. Each game ticket is sold separately, no season passes
2. All tickets will be scanned upon entry either by print out or on your mobile device
3. Ticketed events are ALL VARSITY GAMES and any varsity game that is coupled with another level
 - a. i.e Triple Headers all in one day: 9th, JV and V
 - b. i.e Double header: V and JV
4. We do not charge for home 9th or JV single games.
 - a. JV Football,
 - b. 9th football
 - c. JV soccer

- d. 9th VB, JV VB
 - i. The gates are open for these games on a first come, first serve basis. A ticket is not required unless communicated prior
- 5. Children 6 and Under are **FREE**
- 6. Passes and Discounts:
 - a. STVM Students and Faculty are FREE with proof of STVM issued ID at gate
 - b. Booster Club Discount(s) are given by joining the STVM Athletic Booster Club. Click here for [more information](#)
 - c. Children in grades K-6 are eligible to join [Club Irish](#)
 - d. Shamrock Society Passes
 - i. By giving to The Fund for STVM at a level of \$1,000 or greater, you are automatically in the Shamrock Society. This grants you free entry into all on campus athletic and academic events. [More information here](#)
 - ii. Donors with these passes must present their key chain at the ticket gate upon entry. We ask that all donors planning on attending any HOME event vs Archbishop Hoban or Walsh Jesuit, contact the school prior to your arrival in preparation for high traffic/a sell out

PARKING @ FOOTBALL GAMES:

STVM charges a parking fee for all HOME Football games.

Gravel and paved lot near stadium: \$5

Upper school lot: \$3

AWAY GAMES:

STVM is at the discretion of our opponents when traveling to their sites. We will communicate with our fans on what those other school's policies are. Check www.stvm.com/athletics for weekly updates

COVID-19 Guidelines:
