STVM High School Scholarship/Placement Exam (October/November)

- Exam must be taken at one of the October or November dates
- December date is placement only (not scholarship eligible)

Family & Memorial Scholarship Application

- Complete one of two ways:
- Use Adobe fill-in form functionality, then print off
- Print off and complete by hand, write legibly
- Use only the space provided to answer questions – do not attach additional sheets
- Do not attach other items (i.e. financial documents, resumes, award certificates, newspaper articles, etc.)
- **Important:** Drop application **AND** report card off at STVM Scholarship Office or send via mail (postmarked Wednesday, December 3, 2019)

Copy of 1st Quarter 8th Grades

- Include a copy of 1st quarter 8th grade report card with Family & Memorial Scholarship Application
- Do not send separately (via mail/email/fax) from the Family & Memorial Scholarship Application
- Make sure name is clearly marked

- Submit supporting documents via upload option
- Fax is accepted however it delays processing
