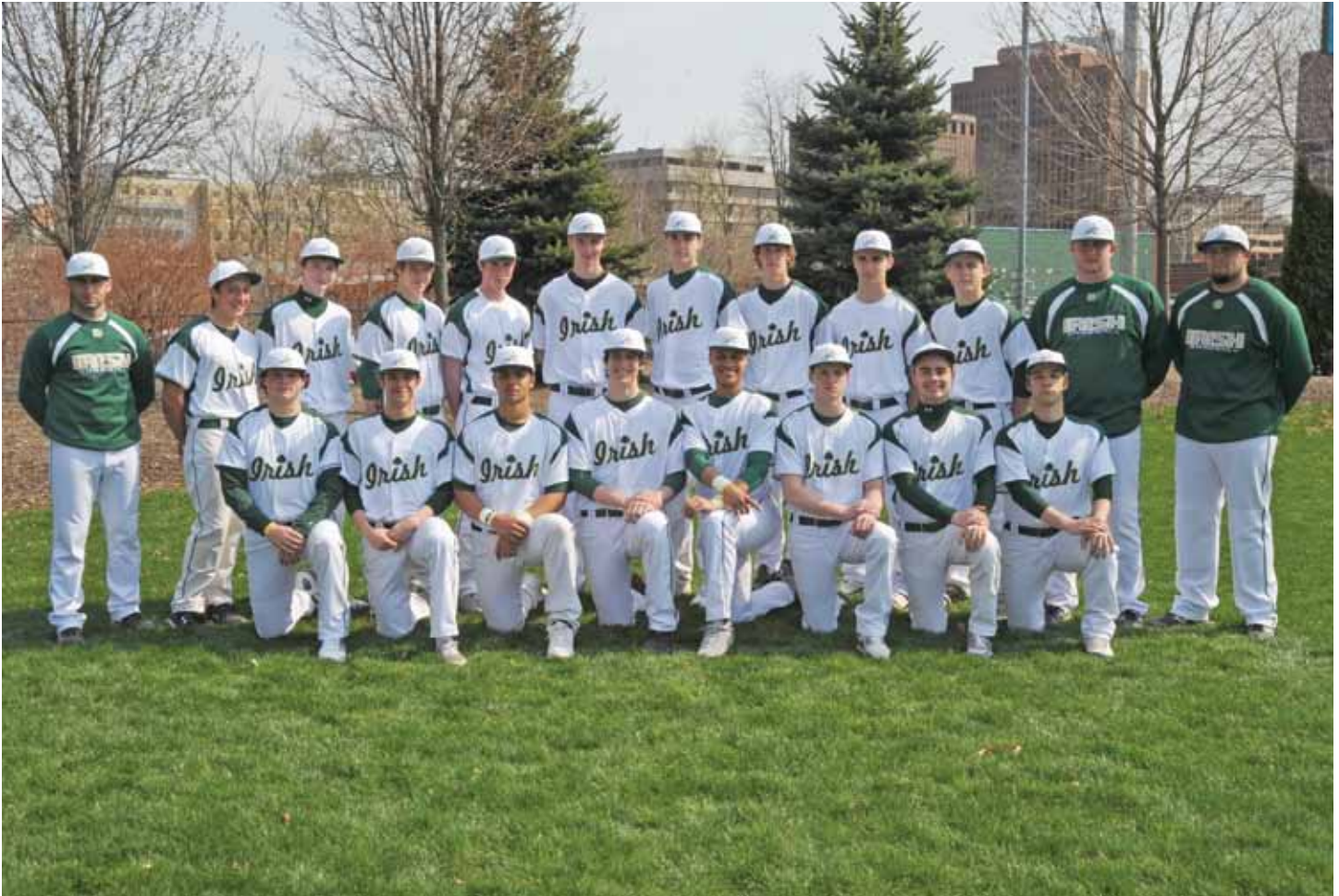

Anthony Boarman Head Coach

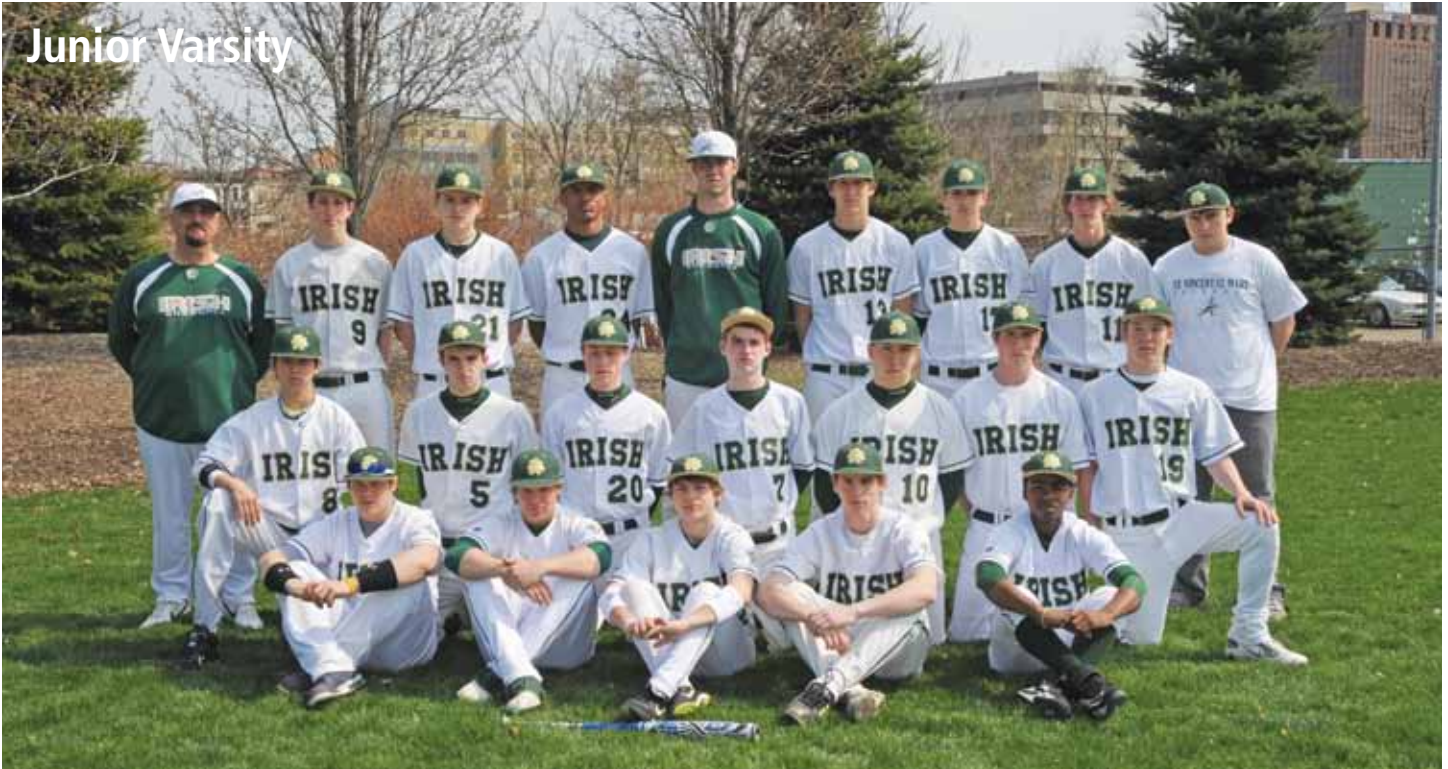

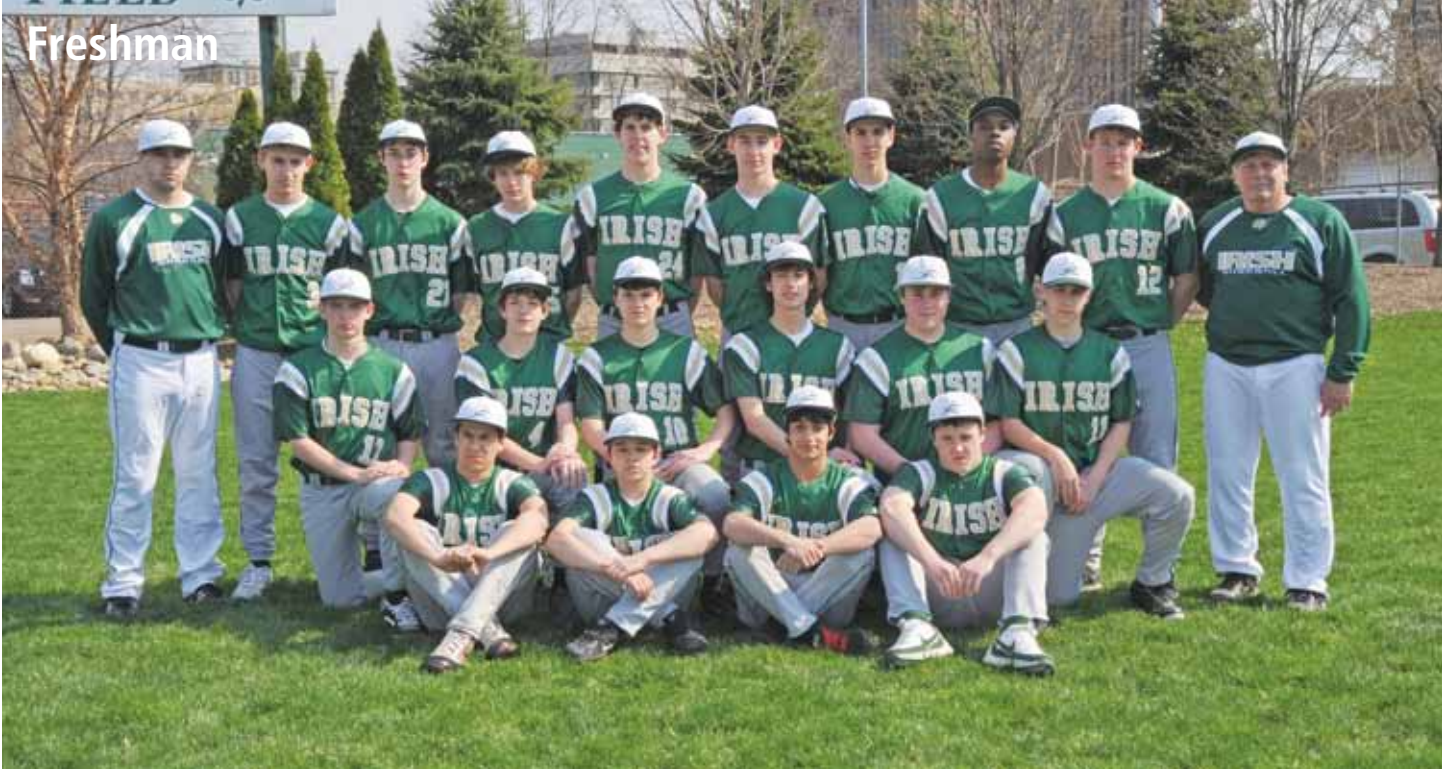

Dan Lancianese begins his 17th year as Head Coach of the Fighting Irish Track Team. Coach Lancianese has 30 years coaching experience and reflects on the past season:

Boys: Placed 5th in the state in the 4x800, 7th in the state at the 4x200. Doran Grant won the 110 hurdles. Jacob Swords took 4th in the 800 meter run.

Girls: Won the state title in the 4x800 relay. Erica Hutson placed 2nd in the 400 meter dash and 7th in the 200 meter dash at the state meet. The girls placed 6th in the state in the 4x200 and took 8th in the 4x400.

Last year's season resulted in 7 new records being set for both the boys and girls. The 2011 goal is to increase the number of state qualifiers for both the boys and girls team.

Athletic Trainer



Once again, for the 2010-2011 school year, St. Vincent-St. Mary High School will offer sports-specific strength and conditioning training for all athletes. The training will be provided by 3rd year Head Wrestling Coach Anthony Gary, who is a personal trainer certified by the National Strength and Conditioning Association (NSCA) and the American Council on Exercise (ACE).

There is no charge to STVM athletes for these services. Gary will work with the students on a program to enhance their performance and prevent injury during the regular season, as well as pre- and post-season. Although athletes are not required to participate, they'll have an opportunity to meet as a team with Gary once or twice a week to learn body weight and stretching exercises, including variations on martial arts and yoga techniques.

"Proper strength and conditioning training is important for preventing injury and improving speed, agility and power," said Gary. "I'm happy to be able to offer this, not only to my wrestlers, but to all athletes at STVM High School."
